### ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Nashoba Regional School District, the Awarding Authority, invites sealed bids from Contractors for the Nashoba Regional High School Effluent Disposal System Modification. General Bids for furnishing and installing the new effluent disposal system will be received at the Nashoba Regional School District Facilities Office at 50 Mechanic Street, Bolton Massachusetts, 01740, until 2:00 PM (EST) on June 7, 2019, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Nashoba Regional High School Wastewater Treatment Facility (12 Green Road, Bolton, MA 01740) office on May 8, 2019 at 10 AM. Attendance at the pre-bid meeting is recommended.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders. The bidding and award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M.

The Work of this Contract generally consists of replacing the existing effluent disposal system associated with the existing onsite wastewater treatment facility with a new system located outside the nearby water supply well IWPA's. The Project shall include, but not necessarily limited to, selected demolition, installation of a submersible duplex pump system and control panel, installation of a new effluent forcemain from the facility to the new effluent disposal field location, and installation of the new effluent disposal fields and monitoring wells. In addition, the Contractor shall be required to maintain flow conditions throughout the duration of the Project; provide for demolition and legal disposal of existing equipment, piping, etc. The Project also includes site improvements including paving, fencing, loaming and seeding; new electrical wires; and all appurtenances and incidentals to make a complete and operational effluent disposal system.

Due to the constraints associated with the site use as a regional high school, the Bidder will fully complete the Project (with all disturbed surfaces backfilled to finish grade and either loamed & seeded or restored to existing conditions) by August 26, 2019. It is anticipated a Notice to Proceed will be issued on July 1, 2019.

**Beginning on May 6, 2019**, copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained from Nashoba Blue, Inc., 433 Main Street, #5, Hudson, Massachusetts, Phone (978) 568-1167 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM. There is a \$100.00 deposit, either by company check or certified or cashier's check, for each set of the Contract Documents requested; made payable to Nashoba Regional School District at the time of obtaining copies. **It is strongly recommended that anyone seeking copies of the Contract Documents call for availability prior to arrival.** Bidders requesting the Contract Documents to be mailed to them shall include a separate check in the amount of \$30.00 per set made payable to the Nashoba Blue to cover processing and mail handling costs. UPS and Federal Express account numbers will not be accepted.

Said payment for Bid Documents shall be refunded to bidders upon return of such Contract Documents in excellent condition (all pages bound with no markings, removed or torn pages, creases, damaged pages, etc.) **to Nashoba Blue**, postpaid if mailed, within 30 days of the Bid opening. Bid Documents returned to the School District's or Engineer's offices will not receive refunds. Refunds will be limited to two sets of Contract Documents for each bidder or non-bidder.

The person obtaining the Contract Documents shall provide a listing comprised of: Name of Company, Address, Phone No., FAX No., email, and work specialty (general contractor, supplier, electrician, and etc.).

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5% of the total Bid amount and in the form described in the Instructions to Bidders. A Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the contract price will be required in the form described in the Instructions to Bidders. Each Bidder shall submit a Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance Certificate of Eligibility in one of the following categories: General Building Construction, Sewage and Water Treatment Plants or Sewage Pump Stations and an update statement (Form CQ3) in accordance with MGL c. 149, s 44D.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Contractor, before Bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed Work under this Contract.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept any bid, to waive any informality, to omit any item or items deemed beneficial for the best interests of the Owner, or to limit the extent of the Work to keep within allocated funding requirements. No Bidder may withdraw their bid within 30 calendar days after the Bid opening date.
