



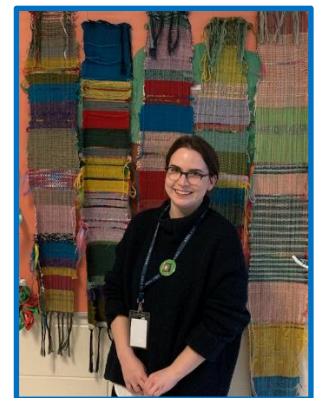
SAORI Weaving
